The BOOST (Buena Out Of School Time) Program is a collaboration of diverse community partners who provide educational programs during non-school hours for students and their families in the Buena Regional School District. The program offers a wide variety of enrichment activities for students throughout the school year including a condensed summer program. Areas of academic enrichment across the curriculum are addressed.

The BOOST Program will provide academically aligned, culturally enlightened, socially responsible, and healthy, family-centered opportunities to our student population. Enrichment activities will expose students to STREAM (Science, Technology, Reading, Engineering, Arts, Math) opportunities and will remain community-based with partners that provide quality services to improve not only student achievement, but also the quality of life for the residents in the community.

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STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

Students presently in grades 3rd through 8th in the Buena Regional School District.

TRANSPORTATION

Bus transportation is provided for all BOOST students at the end of each day. An adult must be present, and on time, at the bus stop every day. Students in grades 6th through 8th may be dropped off without an adult present.

PROGRAM HOURS

- BRMS students in grades 6th through 8th attend BOOST 2:20 pm - 5:20 pm.
- Cleary students in grades 3rd through 5th attend BOOST 3:25 pm – 6:25 pm

ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance is required and is a very important component to the success of the program. Students who miss numerous days in the program may not be permitted to take part in special activities, and/or may be dropped from the program so that we may serve other students and their families. Please notify the BOOST office before 1:30 pm whenever your child will not be attending BOOST. Please also let us know if your child will have an extended absence.

FAMILY NIGHTS

Parental involvement is required and encouraged. BOOST will have monthly Family Nights in which we all get together for fun and activities.

STUDENT CONDUCT
